Installation

1. Insert the USB Stick to the DP700.
2. Connect the Power Cable
3. Turn On the volume. The power LED will turn on and the audio will automatically start to play in about 10 seconds.

NOTE: The LED will either display AL = ALL Files or a number 01, 02, 03 etc for the selected file. To change between ALL & Selected, hold the Select Key down.

4. Connect the Line Isolation to the Dp700. Select the Telephone interface and connect to your telephone system.

If desired, mount the unit on the wall with the mounting plate.

NOTE

The internal speaker is provided for program verification and trouble shooting purposes. It is recommended to be turned off during normal operation in order to save power for environmental concerns.

In case of power outage, the D7-600 will automatically start to play in about 10 seconds after the power is restored.

All files must be named chronologically.

ie 1st File = 001FileName.mp3, 2nd file = 002FileName.mp3 etc

Changing the Music On Hold file

1. Turn off the volume so the unit is off.
 2. Disconnect the USB
 3. Insert USB to the PC, driver will open.
 4. Add/Delete/Change files as required. Up to 99 Files only
- Note: naming convention of files**
5. Eject the USB from the PC and reinsert to Dp700
 6. Turn on DP700 and connect the Power Supply and LIU and test the volume if required.

Trouble shooting

1. The power LED is on but there is no sound.
 - * Make sure the file type is supported.
 - * Make sure the output volume is turned up.
 - * Make sure the LIU is securely connected.
 - * After power-up it takes the unit about 10 seconds to start.
2. The sound quality is poor.
 - * Make sure the LIU is securely connected.
 - * Try turning the volume down a little bit.
